**WCK 01/12 KIPTERE 14/03-28/03 MANU/ENVI/EDU 10vols (majority being local volunteers)**

**Work:** The volunteers will be joining community members in working on the youth group which is the host on their income generating activities which are small scale farming and making of handicrafts. The volunteers will also be involved in workshops in the community and the local schools on HIV/Aids, environmental conservation, conflict resolution and hygiene. Other activities will be community cleanup in local market and hospital.

**Accommodation:** WCK will provide locally available foodstuffs bought from the community. The local youths members will be preparing the volunteer's food but the volunteers could also be of assistance and they will be accommodated in a host family in the community.

**Location:** The project is located in Kiptere on the Kericho – Kisumu road about 30 minutes drive by vans (matatus) from kericho town in the rift valley province which is a tea growing area.

**Terminal:** There is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi which is the city where all volunteers shall be meeting so as to depart to Kericho as a group as World Corps is providing transport to and from the site. World Corps Kenya will pick up volunteer from the airport and will be accommodated in Nairobi for a day before traveling together to the community.

**WCK 02/12/ VOI 18/04-02/05 MANU/ENVI/EDU 10vols (majority being local volunteers)**

**Work:** The volunteers will be working with the community in various environmental and income generating activities that ensure there is reduced human-wildlife conflict and sustainable utilization of the resources available. Working with aloe vera farmers, making of decorations using the elephants dung and having an environmental restoration talks in the primary schools in the community.

**Accommodation:** WCK will provide locally available foodstuffs bought from the community. There will be someone onsite to prepare the volunteer's food but the volunteers could also be of assistance and they will be accommodated in a home provided by the member in the host community.

**Location:** Voi is located in Taita-Taveta district in the coast and lies approximately 200 kilometers to Mombasa city and around 360 kilometers from Nairobi. The community lies on the border of the tsavo national parks which is famous for the man eaters' lions.

**Terminal:** There is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi which is the city where all volunteers shall be meeting so as to depart to Voi as a group as World Corps is providing transport to and from the site. World Corps Kenya will pick up volunteer from the airport and will be accommodated in Nairobi for a day before traveling together to the community.

**WCK 03/12/NAKURU 23/05-06/06 EDU/MANU/HUM 10vols (majority being local volunteers)**

**Work:** The project is a partnership between World Corps Kenya and Hadassah Orphanage center. The center started with 30 children and currently is handling over 200 vulnerable children. The project offers basic Education which is **Nursery school, baby class, middle class and Primary level of classes standard 1, 2 and 3.** The project also feeds these children during break time and lunch break since most of them come to school on an empty stomach since they are from very poor families and its only in the school they can get a little meal.

The volunteers will be working at the center in all the activities within the school including Teaching, cleaning the center, sports with the kids and repairs of the center buildings.

**Accommodation:** WCK will provide locally available foodstuffs bought from the community. The volunteers will be accommodated within the center at the Directors house which is big enough to host 15 volunteers at once.

**Location** The project is located in Mwariki area of Nakuru town which is only two hours drive by

bus from Nairobi and situated at the heart of the Great Rift Valley with scenic sites like Menengai Crater, Lake Nakuru National Park and its famous flamingo just within a walking distance.

**Terminal:** There is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi which is the city where all volunteers shall be meeting so as to depart to Nakuru as a group as World Corps is providing transport to and from the site. World Corps Kenya will pick up volunteer from the airport and will be accommodated in Nairobi for a day before traveling together to the community.

**WCK 04/12 GITHURAI 27/06-11/07 EDU/MANU/HUM 10vols (majority being local volunteers)**

**Work:** The project is a partnership between WCK and the Salem Learning and Rescue Center. The project was started to care for the orphaned and vulnerable children (OVCs) in Githurai which is 30 minutes drive from Nairobi city .The main activity at the center is providing Counseling and care for these children as well as provide them with education, clothing, medical care and security. The center is also involved in income generating activities to make its activities self sustaining through training of the children who are unable to join high school in making detergents, soaps, body lotions and conditioners as well as food like crisps and tomato sauce for sale. Currently the center is hosting 40 OVCs from Githurai and other neighboring areas which is a very highly populated by people who mostly settled in the area because of its close proximity to the capital city. All the children at the center are currently in the school either in high school or primary school. The center also carries out awareness within the community on the importance and various ways that the community can support and participate in the caring of the HIV/Aids orphans. Volunteers will be involved in all activities that are run in the center which include taking care of the children, playing with them, counseling, cleaning, mentoring and teaching.

**Accommodation:** Volunteers will be hosted in the center premises. There will be someone onsite to prepare the volunteer's food but the volunteers could also be of assistance.

**Location:** The center is located in githurai, a suburban of Nairobi only 20 minutes by bus from the city center on the eastern of the city.

**Terminal:** There is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi which is the town where all volunteers shall be meeting so as to depart to Githurai as a group as World Corps is providing transport to and from the site.

**Language: English**

**Special Remarks:** The work may be sometimes manual and involving but there is the possibility of accommodating the physically challenged people.

**WCK 05/12 DUNGA BEACH 01/08-15/08 ENVI/EDU/MANU 10vols (majority being local volunteers)**

**Work:** The volunteers will be joining community members in working on activities that are aimed at conserving the environment; building trenches to reduce destruction caused by the flow of rain water, planting trees, cleaning the water pans, erosion control and educating the community on the importance of conserving the environment.

**Accommodation:** WCK will provide locally available foodstuffs bought from the community. There will be someone onsite to prepare the volunteer's food but the volunteers could also be of assistance and they will be accommodated in a home provided by the member in the host community.

**Location:** The project is located in Dunga beach which is only 15 minutes by matatu (small vans) from Kisumu city. The project site is along the lake Victoria the largest fresh water lake in Africa.

**Terminal:** There is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi which is the city where all volunteers shall be meeting so as to depart to Kisumu as a group as World Corps is providing transport to and from the site. World Corps Kenya will pick up volunteer from the airport and will be accommodated in Nairobi for a day before traveling together to the community.

**Accommodation:** WCK will provide locally available foodstuffs bought from the community. The local youths members will be preparing the volunteer's food but the volunteers could also be of assistance and they will be accommodated in a school which is one of the projects in the community.

**Location:** The project is located in Mogogosiek on the Narok – Kiisi road about 30 minutes drive by vans (matatus) from sosiot town in the rift valley province which is a tea growing area.

**Terminal:** There is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi which is the city where all volunteers shall be meeting so as to depart to Mogogosiek as a group as World Corps is providing transport to and from the site. World Corps Kenya will pick up volunteer from the airport and will be accommodated in Nairobi for a day before traveling together to the community.

Mobilize community members to participate in environmental conservation programs, i.e. building of gabions on eroded areas and digging terraces along roads among others.

The kids under the special unit care are taught both the oral and written skills like the normal children and also technical skills. They unit has a workshop where the kids are trained in wood work, tailoring and other artistic skills.

Volunteers will be assisting the teachers in all the activities including teaching and in the workshop. Volunteers need not to have training in special education for them to volunteer but the love for kids is a must. **Accommodation:** Volunteers will be hosted in a host family who has a big house with several rooms that can accommodate maximum of 15 volunteers in shared rooms. The host family is only 20 minutes drive to the school. There will be someone onsite to prepare the volunteer's food but the volunteers could also be of assistance.

**Location:** Toi is located in Nairobi only 20 minutes drive from the city center and it borders Kibera one of the biggest slums in sub Saharan Africa.

**Terminal:** There is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi which is the town where all volunteers shall be meeting so as to depart to the host family which is few minutes drive from the Airport.

**Special Remarks:** The work is manual and involving but there is the possibility of accommodating the physically challenged people.
