### **LOCATION OF THE PROJECT**

**The working place is:** Tuy Hoa city, Phu Yen

### **BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT**

Located in Tuy Hoa city, C&C center is the English language center for disadvantaged children aging from 5 – 14 years old. It is now doing its great tasks together with the long-term volunteers from SJ Vietnam to support free training courses and learning materials for poor and ethnic students. Volunteers are expected to organize English classes with games, songs, etc. Volunteers will help the children with painting and organize a workshop showing those painting in which all the kids' parents will be invited to the show. Furthermore, a sport competition will be held after the kids are trained some games by volunteers and the excursion with the kids to a beauty sport will be an occasion for volunteers to know more about the kids.

### **ROLES AND TASKS OF VOLUNTEERS**

Volunteers will have daily activities as:

- Organize leisure activities for children, teach Basic English through games, activities, songs...
- Volunteers will organize and run different workshops including: sport; art; music; painting
- Volunteers will have chance to exchange with students at different high schools and universities in Tuy Hoa city.

All of volunteers will be divided into smaller groups in order to take care of above-mentioned tasks during the camp. There are also other activities of cultural interaction among the group such as learning foreign languages, introducing cultures,... in the free time.

### **DAILY LIFE**

#### **Accommodation and food**

Volunteers will sleep in the Guest House of Phu Yen Education Center with basic and simple accommodation. Meals are self-prepared by volunteers. Vietnamese food is considered as easy to eat but if you have special diet, please inform in advance.

### **Leisure and exchange activities**

Free times should be used for inter-cultural and leisure activities of the group. So please come with some ideas of games and entertainment. The group also has chances to self-organize some other activities such going out for coffee, karaoke, smoothies in the evening.

Volunteers will have weekend off, a chance for everyone to travel and take an interesting and relaxing break together. There are beaches close to Saigon or maybe a trip into the Mekong Delta region. SJV does not cover this cost for you but we can help arrange with ideas and planning details.

### **SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Be able to do manual work and organize activities for kids.
- Strong inter-personal skills, and experience in working with a wide variety of people, cultural sensitivity.
- Commitment to volunteerism, considerable experience as a volunteer.
- High motivation, ready to live as local people (basic accommodations, transport by bus or bicycle, local food) and ready to be in face of many difficulties such as language and culture difference, low budget, etc.
- Be patient and sympathetic with disadvantaged children.

### **WHAT TO BRING:**

For themselves, volunteers should bring:

- Air mattress (if necessary)
- Mosquito net.



- Pillow.
- Raincoat.
- Some long sleeve shirts, modest clothes to work with children and visit some cultural sites (pagoda, temple, etc)
- A basic pharmacy kit

For the project, volunteers should bring:

- Info materials and pictures of your country.
- Toys and learning materials for the children if you have.
- Colorful markers for drawing and workshops.
- You can also bring some traditional ingredients for intercultural night.

## HOW TO GET TO MEETING POINT

1. From Ho Chi Minh city
  - By train: daily trains leave Hoa Hung train station at 19:30. It costs 339,000VND for the comfortable soft seats and air-condition, taking 11 hours.
  - By bus: daily buses leave Ben Xe Mien Dong at variety of time but we don't recommend you to travel by bus because it's not very safe 😊. Once you arrive at the bus station, you will see Le Trung Kien street in front of the station, go along the street then you will see the train station which is about 300m from the bus station.
  - By plane: daily flight to Tuy Hoa city leaves at 14:15, taking 1hour and 15 minutes, costs about 1,400,000VND/one way. Please check out for more information at the website: <http://www.vietnamairlines.com.vn>. Once you arrive at the airport, take a taxi to the train station, it takes about 15 minutes, costs about 100,000VND (5usd)

**For the one who can come earlier, please follow the instruction:**

If you come to the project site earlier, you can stay at the hotel at the price ranging from 7 – 10usd/day.

**FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND CONDITION**

The total fee is 5,000,000VND/participant in including local transportation around the campsite, food, basic accommodation and materials for the workcamp. This fee will be transferred at least 2 weeks before the camp starts. SJ Vietnam covers transfer fee in our participation fee. Please deduct it from 5,000,000 VND when you make the transfer from your country.

If you already travel out of your country much earlier than 2 weeks which makes you can't transfer the amount, we will ask you to make a local bank transfer in Vietnam of 5,000,000 VND and of course you should take care of the transfer fee out of our participation fee.

Participation fees enable SJ Vietnam to take care of your stay and to fund their projects.

Volunteers have to pay by themselves extra fee if they want to travel at the weekend.
