BACKGROUND OF PROJECT SITE

A part of South-Western Region of Vietnam, Dong Thap is a province with highly developed agriculture industry. It adjoins Cambodia to the North and 3 other local provinces to the West, East and South.

A typical province in Mekong Delta, Dong Thap has a complex system of rivers, channels as well as big lakes and ponds. Taking advantages of its large water body, Dong Thap has developed a very convenient transportation system. And as it is a very agriculture-focused province, Dong Thap produces many valuable types of rice, poultry and seafood. Nowadays, the most popular sceneries are borderless rice fields and peaceful boats floating on the channels.

Dong Thap is in the tropical climate zone, consistently in the whole province. There are two evident seasons; rainy season from May to Nov, and dried season from Dec to Apr of the following year. Average rainfall ranges from 1,682-2,005mm, mostly in rainy season which accounts for 90-95% of annual rainfall. Such climate is fairly advantageous for agricultural development. The average temperature is 27oC, of which the highest is 34.3oC, and lowest is 21.8oC. The hydrology of the province is under the influence of 3 factors: floodwater from upper Mekong River, in-field rain and tides of the South East Asia Sea. The hydrologic regime is divided into 2 seasons:

exhausted season from Dec to Jun of the following year and flood season from Jul to Nov.

Enjoying a temperate climate, wide irrigation system, permanent fresh-water source supplied by Tien River and Hau River, and rich river deposit, the agriculture of Dong Thap keeps growing well. At present, Dong Thap is the 3rd largest rice paddy in Vietnam with a planted area of 462,042ha and paddy output of more than 2.8 million tons. Dong Thap is also well known for fruits, specifically as Cao Lanh mango, Lai Vung mandarin, Chau Thanh long an and Phong Hoa grapefruit (fruit-able during the year), etc. which bring about high economic values for gardeners. Within the province, there are various typical orchards having been specialized to produce consistent quality fruits, which aim at building up brand-name and meeting export requirements. In Cao Lanh, almost local people doing farming in the rice fields and gardening. A day closes quite early as local people go to bed around 10pm.

ROLES AND TASKS

- Together with activities for children, the group also help with doing a small construction at the school.
- The group will discuss and prepare to organize various activities to entertain as well as help in non-formal education for local kids at An Binh B primary. Topics to be carried out: Health care; Traditional games; Environmental education; Sports.
- There will be a small workshop organized between local youth and the group to discuss and share from each other on “Rubbish – Collect and Process”.

DAILY LIFE

Accommodation food:

Volunteers will stay at the hotel or guest house. Meals will be served in Vietnamese style with rice and a lot of vegetables, meat and seafood.

Leisure and exchange activities:

There will be a Cultural Exchange Show organized at Dong Thap university/Local Youth Union of Cao Lanh District in order to exchange in terms of food, performances (singing, dancing, fashion) with local students..

To explore floating market, islands on river and coconut production, enjoy traditional music of Mekong.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ability to do manual work.
- Willing to work and stay in small town.
- Strong inter-personal skills, and experience in working with a wide variety of people, cultural sensitivity.
- Commitment to volunteerism
- High motivation and come ready to live as the locals do (basic accommodations, transport by bus or bicycle, local food). Be ready to face many difficulties such as language barriers, culture differences, low budgets, etc.
- Be patient and empathetic with the disabled children
- Follow rules of the centre

HOW TO GET TO MEETING POINT



International Airport: take a taxi from the taxi rank in front of arrivals. It's best to walk left and take a taxi from there – not the Saigon Airport Taxi. Take the taxi to **Ben Thanh bus station** and the price is around **180.000 VND** (9 USD). The ticket for the taxi to exit the airport toll gate is **10.000**
