LOCATION OF YOUR PROJECT

The Working place is CEC at No 114 Le Trung Kien street, Tuy Hoa city, Phu Yen

BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT

CEC is an environment for children aged from 6-15 years old and an English supportive center for adults who take part in in-service training and associate

training courses with universities and colleges throughout the country. In Phu Yen, volunteers will teach English to children and support the teachers to improve the english teaching methods.

ROLES AND TASKS

The long-term volunteer will be a full member of the national and international SJ Vietnam organization. Volunteers will teach English to children and create a friendly environment in order to encourage communication in English. Volunteers will be the teachers and they are expected to teach grammar and other aspects of English to their own classes which may have more than 10 students.

Volunteers encourage the students to learn English by organizing leisure activities in English (audio, books, etc) and by providing self-study materials. They can help the teachers and staffs with other tasks in the school.

DAILY LIFE

Working plan can be as below:

Morning: 8h – 11h; Afternoon: 5h30 – 7h

Volunteers will work from Tuesday to Saturday. Sundays and Mondays are usually off work but this can be changed due to the working plan of the center.

Orientation

SJ Vietnam organizes 3 days of orientation for each new volunteer. One of the LTV coordinators will be your privileged contact during this orientation week and volunteers will welcome you on their project. They will help you to have a clearer idea about Vietnam's culture, your project, as well as Do's and Don'ts in Vietnam. Furthermore, they will give you the contact of a buddy who will assist you during your duration of the project☺. Your buddy will join you on some activities, will take you on a city tour, show you some museums and famous places in the area and can help you to make bookings; he or she will be there during the whole duration of your project in order to make your life easier.

The CEC Center will provide basic accommodations with hot showers and kitchen facilities are available. Meals will be provided at the canteen of the center. Volunteers will have to pay if they choose to eat outside.

Internet is available at the center.

Day off and holidays:

You have 2 days off per week. Mostly during the weekend, unless there are special events in your working place.

Extra information

Phu Yen is a coastal province in the southern central coast of Vietnam. Phu Yen has a favorable transport system in roads, railways, air and water. Tuy Hoa city is the provincial center, 1160 kilometers from Ha Noi capital, 400 kilometers from Da Nang city, 120 kilometers from Nha Trang city and 560 kilometers from Ho Chi Minh city following the National Highway. Visitors can come to Phu Yen by coaches, planes or ships.



The landscape of Nhan Mountain and Da Rang River is considered the symbol of Phu Yen, leaving deep impressions for visitors when coming to Phu Yen. Standing at the height of 64 meters on its top, visitors can enjoy the whole view of Tuy Hoa city along the seashore of the China Sea and the Da Rang river with four bridges running in parallel across the river.

With its history of 400 years, Phu Yen has still been preserving hundreds of historic and cultural vestiges, in which there are 13 historic, cultural and landscape vestiges classified as national level. These vestiges together with the stone lithophone and stone bugles are dated back to about 2,500 years ago. The traditional craft villages and the typical cultural features of the ethnic minority

communities in the province will be a very valuable resource for the visitors interested in sight-seeing, research and study.

Meeting point and meeting time

Meeting point: Tuy Hoa train station, Le Trung Kien Street, Tuy Hoa City

HOW AND WHEN TO GET THE MEETING POINT

1. From Ho Chi Minh city
 - By train: daily trains leave Hoa Hung train station at 19:30. It costs 339,000VND for the comfortable soft seats and aircon, taking 11 hours.
 - By bus: daily buses leave Ben Xe Mien Dong at variety of time but we don't recommend you to travel by bus because it's not very safe ☺. Once you arrive at the bus station, you will see Le Trung Kien street in front of the station, go along the street then you will see the train station which is about 300m from the bus station.
 - By plane: daily flight to Tuy Hoa city leaves at 14:15, taking 1hour and 15 minutes, costs around 1,400,000VND/one way. Once you arrive at the airport, take a taxi to the train station, it takes about 15 minutes, costs about 150,000VND (7usd)

PARTICIPATION FEE AND CONFIRMATION PROCESS

The monthly fee is 7,500,000VND/month. This fee includes food, transportation and basic accommodation with a host family. Volunteers will pay all their participation fees in a single payment to their sending organizations or directly to SJ Vietnam 2 weeks before their arrival in Vietnam. Volunteers must send a scanned copy of the receipt and bring it to SJ Vietnam. If they do not pay their participation fees before coming, they will be put on the waiting list. The volunteers can choose their length of stay but must pay in increments of whole or half months. For example, if volunteers stay for 3 months and 10 days, they must pay for 3 and a half months – the cost will be 26,250,000VND; if they stay for 3 months and 20 days, they are must pay for 4 months – the cost will be 30,000,000VND.

If there are holidays during the duration of the volunteer's time here it will still be considered part of their volunteer time and they must pay for the duration of

the holiday. If holidays fall after the volunteer work with SJ Vietnam is finished there will be no additional costs.
