SFERA is International social movement of support of voluntary initiatives. It was established in March 2007 by uniting the efforts of youth non-governmental organizations from different subjects of Russian Federation. The headquarter is situated in Nizhniy Novgorod, Russia. The aim of the organization is development and support of youth initiatives by providing young people with access to volunteering, regardless of nation, religion, social status and background. Nowadays, there are 6 people in staff of SFERA and more than 500 volunteers regularly participate in different activities.

The main SFERA activities are:

- international voluntary workcamps,
- EVS projects,
- educational activities for youngsters and organizations involved in social service,
- promotions campaigns of volunteering,
- charity and social services.

SFERA Movement is a member of Alliance of European Voluntary Organizations (Alliance) and a partner of Service Civil International (SCI). Since 2007 SFERA is one of the official multipliers of Erasmus + (Youth in Action programme) in EECA countries.

DISTANCE

It makes no sense to point out, that Russia is a big country and it seems like it takes ages to get from one point to another. This summer we decided to show you different parts of our country and we have a few projects in distant places. Although, it's quite easy and not so expensive to get there. Firstly, we have a new low cost airline "Pobeda" where you can get really cheap tickets for domestic flights. Secondly, comfortable night trains are popular and wide spread in our country and one can get the cheapest tickets 45 days before the date of travel (moreover, railway service is generally cheaper than in Europe). So, don't be afraid of distances in Russia and be ready that "just 6 hours by train" is actually not a lot.

INVITATION PROCESS AND VISA

There are a lot of legends coming around visa process in Russian consulates. Although we believe that those legends are just made up and it's not so scary. Since the majority of foreigners need an entrance visa to come to Russia, it's recommended to apply not later than 1 month before the project. We provide official invitation letters from our organization for volunteers. Find more about visas in Appendix 1.

LANGUAGE

Please keep in mind that English is not wide spoken in Russia in general and it might be a bit challenging. Also signs are not always transliterated into latin letters.

INSURANCE

Unfortunately SFERA Movement does not provide medical insurance and it's highly recommended for volunteers to take out their own medical insurance and to take their own medicine that they use in their home country

The host of the camp is an independent nonprofit organization Informational and Educational Centre "Sodruzhestvo" located in Ryazan.

Children in the camp have a chance to improve their knowledge of Economics and English, and also develop other talents. For volunteers, this camp has a good opportunity for exchange of teaching experience and original ideas in non-formal educational and special cultural events.

The camp place is situated in Ryazan region (90 km from Ryazan) in the national park Meschera so the participants will have an opportunity to enjoy beautiful Russian nature.

Ryazan is an ancient Russian town about 190 km southeast of Moscow. It is beautifully located on the Oka river, with a very romantic Kremlin, standing high above the city. Ryazan has a beautiful ensemble of churches and monastery buildings with typical Russian golden domes.

WORK

Volunteers will be involved in organisation of educational and fun activities for children. They are expected to conduct linguistic workshops, prepare different events, organize and judge sport matches. Another task for volunteers is to organize the days of their own countries for the children.

ACCOMMODATION

Volunteers will stay in the camp buildings (4 persons per room). Shared facilities. Food will be provided in the canteen.

LANGUAGE

English, (any level of Russian is welcomed).

LEISURE TIME

Excursions to Ryazan city and settlement Konstantinovo (where the famous Russian poet Sergei Esenin was born) and ancient cloister named Poschupovo. Different sport games like football, volleyball, ping-pong and swimming are available for the volunteers.

TERMINAL

Moscow train station and airport. The volunteers will be met there.

DURATION: 21 days

The project is organized in the south of Russia on the coast of the Black sea. This camp has been organized several times already in cooperation with experienced NGO "Falcogroup".

The camp is aimed at development of intercultural dialogue and tolerance, interest to different countries and cultures, intercultural learning, communication skills, sustainable friendship and study of English language. It was created for children and teenagers, who want to develop their communication skills, express and implement their ideas and creativity.

WORK

Volunteers will organize language workshops for children, play communicative games with them, make presentations about different countries, organize cultural and art events for children, organize and participate in sport activities.

ACCOMMODATION

Volunteers will stay in rooms for 5-6 persons, (shower and toilets are in each room). Washing facilities are available. Food will be provided 3 times per day. Unfortunately vegetarian meals can not be provided and the menu is not flexible.

English

LEISURE TIME

Swimming in the Black sea, hiking, sport games.

TERMINAL

The nearest train station is Tuapse, the nearest airports are Sochi and Krasnodar.

REQUIREMENTS

Before coming to the workcamp volunteers will have Skype meeting with the organizers in order to be well-prepared for the programme tasks. Volunteers should provide the document from their doctor that they are healthy and are permitted to work with children.

The camp will be hosted in the children Center "Berezka" that implements children camps and _____non-formal educational activities for children in Yaroslavl region since 1965 year. Every year the Center hosts more than 2000 children. During the every shift a lot of educational and entertaining activities are organized for children by professional educators and animators. The Center hosts international volunteers for already 4 years.

WORK

Volunteers will organize English classes for children, help with different educational, cultural and sport activities during the camp.

ACCOMMODATION

Rooms for 2-3 people. Food will be provided by the canteen.

LANGUAGE

English

LEISURE TIME

Fishing, swimming, sport activities, excursions, learning Russian language.

TERMINAL

Yaroslavl train station or airport.

REQUIREMENTS

Volunteers should provide the document from their doctor that they are healthy and are permitted to work with children.

NOTES

The camp is located near Yaroslavl in a very picturesque place near the river.

Yaroslavl - one of the oldest Russian cities, founded in the XI century and reached its heyday in the XVII century, in 2010 the city celebrated its millennium. The historic city center, situated at the confluence of the Volga and the Kotorosl rivers, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Yaroslavl is traditionally considered one of the main objects of the Golden Ring of Russia.

The camp is hosted by Smolensk regional public youth organization "Rassvet-S" on the base of a rehabilitation center for children and youth "Cherry". The center was established in 1981 as a children's health-improving camp. Since 2006 it became a rehabilitation centre for children. Every year the center hosts about 3000 children. There are children with different kinds of disabilities: infantile cerebral paralysis and other physical and mental disabilities.

WORK

Volunteers will help to organize entertaining activities and sport games for the children. Also they will help tutors in the activities aimed at the social rehabilitation of disabled children: games, painting, organizing workshops. Volunteers together with children will attend hiking tour and will be asked to help tutors to take care of the children and help with technical things like cook food, make fire, set tents etc. Also volunteers will be asked to organize open air events for children who live in the Center and other children in the city: concerts, games, workshops. Volunteers will participate in the round table with guests from the city social services "Volunteering without borders". Help with renovation of the center (cleaning, painting, etc)

ACCOMMODATION

Rooms for 5-7 people in a building with all facilities (bathroom, toilet; it is also possible to organize laundering). Food will be prepared in the canteen.

LANGUAGE

English

LEISURE TIME

Having picnics in the forest, making a tour in Smolensk city. The volunteers will be able to visit Smolensk Kremlin and the most interesting museums, including a Second World War museum and a Diamond processing factory. Also a trip to a national park "Smolensk lakeside" is planned. Volunteers will have opportunity to see real Russian village.

TERMINAL

Smolensk train station or airport.

REQUIREMENTS

The camp is organized by the Center of Tourism Development of Kirov Region for active volunteers aged 15 - 25 eager to learn about the history and culture of Kirov region and contribute to the developing of tourism while working as part of an international team. Participants of the camp will visit the Paleontological Museum in Kirov and Kotelnich, Dinopark and pareiasaur findspot in Kotelnich District. Volunteers will provide all possible assistance in landscaping of the Dinopark and pareiasaur findspot and visit the village of Leninskaya Iskra and History of the Peasantry Museum which offers an interesting program introducing the guests to traditional folk culture.

WORK

Creating photo, video and other promotional materials about Kirov region, the project, and international volunteering will be an important part of the program. Volunteers will be engaged in a rich cultural programme and are expected to be able to share about their experience online in the form of posts, creation of photo and video materials and tour routes; Translation of materials and helping plan interactive an excursion at the local Paleontological Museum will be an important part of the project, as well; Volunteers will also carry out ecological work in the open-air Dino-park: cleaning of the territory, gardening, taking care of the exhibits; Volunteers should be also ready to make presentations of their own culture for other camp participants and local youth.

ACCOMMODATION

Volunteers will stay in the school building (female and male rooms).
Shower will be provided. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be organized at the local cafe.

LANGUAGE

English

LEISURE TIME

Excursions, workshops on Russian folk culture, Russian sauna (banya), intercultural events. International culture nights as well as team-building and leadership trainings will also be an important part of the program.

TERMINAL

Kotelnich (Kirov region), 123 km from Kirov. Transport from Kirov to Kotelnich is provided by the host organization. The nearest terminal is Kirov railway station and airport.

The goal of the camp is to create conditions to enrich the experience of young people in self-organizing their leisure and everyday life, the development of cross-cultural interaction. Volunteers will work in the team of professional group leaders, sport trainers and instructors and animators.

WORK

Volunteer will help to organize ice-breakers, teambuilding, sports and outdoor games, youth leisure activities. Run workshops about culture of their country. The workshops should include stories about traditions, customs, folk games, cuisine, language of the country presented. Volunteers can work and support professional workers in: non-formal education activities (workshops about different cultures and

languages, healthy life style etc.) art activities (art workshops, preparing evening concerts and performances).

ACCOMMODATION

Tents for 3-4 people, (sleeping bag and a mattress are required). Toilets and showers will be organized in special cabins outside. Unfortunately, vegetarian food can not be provided! Therefore, the desire and ability to eat meat is a very important condition for work in the camp :)

Swimming, sport activities, hiking. Volunteers will be able to visit places of pagan prayers of Mari - sacred groves in the reserve and go camping with other participants.

TERMINAL

Kirov railway station and airport. Transfer will be provided.

Volunteers should be able to communicate with children, know different game forms of work with young people, have presentation skills, be sociable, responsible, organized, meat eater and ready to live in field conditions. Medical document that proves permission to work with children.

NOTES

The camp is located in beautiful botanical and geological complex Chimbulatskiy that has a river, a small mountain as well as forest and field landscapes. Volunteers will have a chance to be totally isolated from the civilization and feel a part of nature.

HEART OF THE TAIGA

LOCATION: Vuktyl, The Republic of Komi

DURATION: 14 days

The camp is organized by the Republican center of the youth initiative support, based on Ministry of Education and Youth Policy of the Republic of Komi. The Republic of Komi is a federal subject of Russia. It is situated to the west of the Ural Mountains and very famous for its rich forests. Virgin Komi Forests is the first natural UNESCO World Heritage site in Russia and the largest expanse of virgin forests in Europe. The main aim of the workcamp is conservation and safeguard of the natural heritage. It's a great chance to see breathtaking landscapes, geological monuments, hike and explore Russia's largest natural park. Volunteers will follow a route of 128 km by the picturesque river in canoe on the territory of the national

park "Yugyd Va".

WORK

Volunteers will rafting along the river exploring the Taiga forest. They are also expected to mark touristic paths with special signs and do easy physical work like cleaning bushes and path from natural garbage (old trees and branches).

ACCOMMODATION

As volunteers will follow a route along the river, they are going to stay in tents and special wooden shelters (shelters have saunas with a possibility to wash and to wash clothes) Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be cooked in the specially organized field kitchen.

Swimming, sport activities, hiking.

TERMINAL

Syktyvkar railway station or airport. Transfer will be provided.

REQUIREMENTS

Hiking rug, sleeping bag, hiking warm clothes, waterproof shoes, raincoat, personal hygiene means + medical insurance is necessary. (Special healthcare products – if needed). Please be ready for field conditions as the camp actually is a big hike.

NOTES

As the workcamp takes place in the forest, there is no internet or mobile connection. Volunteers will be supported by the staff of the National Park with a sat phone in case of emergency. On the last 2 days of the camp volunteers will have a guided tour around the city of Syktyvkar and Finno-Ugric ethno cultural park. Please don't be afraid that it might seem far from Moscow! We have low-cost airlines "Pobeda" and you can get really cheap tickets from Moscow to Syktyvkar. Use this once in a life time opportunity! This region is famous for its amazingly beautiful nature.

- carrying out environmental actions;
- organization of ecological events and festival for local people.

ACCOMMODATION

Tents for 2-3 persons. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be cooked by cooks in the specially organized field kitchen.

LEISURE TIME

Volunteers will play group and sport games. It's also possible to go fishing, walk in real Siberian forest, and attend the workshops from biologists and ecologists about local flora and fauna..

TERMINAL

Novosibirsk train station or airport.

REQUIREMENTS

Sleeping bags and medical insurance are necessary.

NOTES

Novosibirsk is one of the biggest and popular Siberian Russian cities. About 1,5 million people live there. Novosibirsk - is a scientific, cultural, industrial, transport, trade and business center of Siberia. Scientific Center, Siberian Branch of Russian Academy of Sciences is located in Novosibirsk. The biggest university is Novosibirsk State Technical University (NSTU), in which over 22 thousand students study. This city is called the center of science and students.

The camp is organized by the Voluntary Center "UNIVOL" based on Tomsk State University. Tomsk is one of the oldest cities in Siberia and considered as educational and science center. That is why every summer there is a camp for students, which is aimed at leadership and active citizenship development. This summer, the main topic of the camp is volunteering and its benefits for personal and global development. Tomsk also is a city of springs. There are approximately 1014 springs in the city, but unfortunately, native people underestimate their value. Except one enthusiast who has been preserving the springs by himself for last 50 years. That's why, presence of international volunteers is important for dragging attention to this problem.

WORK

During the first part of the camp volunteers will help with cleaning and maintaining the springs system. They will also make a promotional video about the springs and their importance in order to preserve them. During the second part, volunteers will actively participate in students' summer camp "University Collider". They will be expected to prepare some educational activities about volunteering (games, workshops, movie discussions, stories about your personal —————volunteering experience and inspiring cases from your country, etc.) And finally will present the video about the springs.

ACCOMMODATION

Students dormitory in the city of Tomsk, shared facilities. 2 people per room. Food will be served 3 times a day in University canteen.

LANGUAGE

English

LEISURE TIME

Tomsk is a relatively big city full of students and opportunities for spending free time.

TERMINAL

Tomsk or Novosibirsk. You can easily get there from Moscow International Airport or get unforgettable experience in taking Trans-Siberian railway.

REQUIREMENTS

Participants should be motivated to share their personal volunteering experience and promote this idea.

NOTES

It's easy and not expensive to go to Krasnoyarsk (to see very famous Lena pillars), and the Baikal lake after the camp.

DATES: July 06 - July 20

WORK: ENVI\AGRI\CULT\FEST

LOCATION: Otradnoye, St.Petersburg region

DURATION: 14 days

The host for this project is a very nice elderly woman. She runs a small folk center of Russian traditions and she needs help in maintaining and developing. Volunteers will have a great opportunity to know what it feels like to have a grandmother in a village and know more about traditional Russian rural life. Volunteers will learn a lot about traditional rural life in Russia, old traditions and folklore, Russian mythology.

WORK

The main tasks in this project will be connected with farming: weeding, watering, collecting berries, herbs, and hay. Be ready for physical work as painting fence and flatten the ground. Volunteers will also prepare the ground for gardening medicinal herbs and will get a common knowledge about them. During the second week of the camp volunteers will help with organization of the local folk festival. They will have an opportunity to gain new skills and run folk workshops by their own on the festival.

ACCOMMODATION

Volunteers will stay in a wooden house, 3 persons per room. There is an equipped kitchen on the first floor. Bathroom is situated in another building and available for 2 hours after work every day. The toilet is outhouse. Washing machine is available. Volunteers will be in charge of cooking and cleaning the house.

LANGUAGE

English

LEISURE TIME

Volunteers will be able to visit St. Petersburg and surroundings during weekends. At free time there is an opportunity to go swimming, walk in the forest and pick up mushrooms and berries. It's a good idea to take your favorite board games and musical instruments. There is also a nice fireplace near the house for evening gathering.

The project is organized by ITMO University in St. Petersburg. It's one of the leading Universities in Russia in the field of information and photonic technologies. Together with high level educational work University provides students with opportunities for social life. There are student government, student ecological group and voluntary organization dealing with different social issues.

International volunteers will cooperate with students involved in environmental voluntary work in order to exchange with the best practices, develop solidarity and mutual understanding between young people from different countries. Volunteers will work outside of the city in the University educational sport Center for students "Yagodnoe" (100 km from St. Petersburg).

WORK

Volunteers will be asked to implement following tasks:

- collect and separate garbage in the touristic area near the Center,
- clean campfires in touristic places,
- organize non-formal education ecological activities for tourists,
- pave hiking paths,
- renovation work in the Center.

Volunteers will work about 6 hours a day. In addition, volunteers will take part in lectures on medicinal plants and ecological features of garbage collection.

ACCOMMODATION

Volunteers will stay in wooden houses in the rooms for 2-4 persons. Showers and toilets will be provided in the separated houses. Breakfasts, lunches and dinners will be provided by a canteen.

The main aim of this camp is to organize a street festival of sports and arts for people with disabilities. The camp is organized by the Center of Volunteering Development of Karelia which is based in Petrozavodsk. This organization is very experienced in working not only with local, but also with international volunteers. Petrozavodsk is the capital city of the Republic of Karelia, in the Northern part of Russia and very famous for beautiful nature and historically significant Lake Onega. Petrozavodsk is a quite big city with a lot of possibilities to spend free time.

WORK

The main task for the volunteers will be to prepare space to let people with disabilities try themselves in creative area (music playing, songs singing, poems performing, etc). Volunteers will come up with ideas of creative activities, develop programme and schedule of the festival. They will also run workshops, organize ecological short movies show with discussion, and help with decorating the festival area.

ACCOMMODATION

Volunteers will be accommodated in the youth center, shared rooms for 5-6 people. Sleeping bags are necessary! Shared facilities.

Food – self-service. Bring your favorite food and spices for national food party.

LANGUAGE

English

LEISURE TIME

Volunteers will have a guided tour around Petrozavodsk. It's quite a big city, so there are some things to do there. Volunteers will also be able to play boardgames and on the weekend, they will be taken to the Kivach National Reserve where they will visit famous Kivach falls. It's also possible to go swimming and fishing.

TERMINAL

Petrozavodsk airport, railway station, bus station. It's easy to get there from St. Petersburg

REQUIREMENTS

Participants should be motivated to work with people with disabilities and share their art skills.

INVITATION PROCESS AND VISA

It is true that the visa process for Russian workcamps takes more time comparing to other countries. It depends on such institutions like the Ministry of Internal Affairs and the _____ Migration Service where we have to apply for official invitation letters for volunteers. The invitation process depends on the country you are from and that's why it takes different time.

FOR EU CITIZENS

We do not have to apply to the Migration Service for the invitations for volunteers coming from EU countries and can print our own invitations in our office. As the result visa process for EU volunteers has become easier and faster.

TIME

Invitation and visa process takes only 2-3 weeks for the post delivery of the invitation and a week for the visa issuing in Russian consulate.

DEADLINE

Deadline for applications to camps in Russia is 1 month before the start of each workcamp.

FOR NON-EU CITIZENS

TIME

Invitation and visa process takes 1 month for making invitation, 3 weeks for the post delivery of the invitation and about a week for the visa issuing in Russian consulate.

DEADLINE

Deadline for applications to camps in Russia is 9-10 weeks before the start of each workcamp.

AFTER YOU RECEIVED THE CONFIRMATION FOR THE CAMP

Please contact Russian consulate in your country, and find out if you need to have the original invitation letter or the fax copy will be enough, and also find out what are the other documents you need to get a visa. The type of your visa is **Humanitarian** or **Youth relationship**! And if it's necessary to make appointment to Russian consulate. So when you get an invitation you will be already prepared to apply for visa.
